

Eureka “Run What Ya Brung” Drag Race

Event Rules

1. Absolutely NO alcoholic beverages or controlled substance use, or possession, will be allowed on the Eureka Airport Properties at any time. Intoxicated subjects will not be allowed access to the event/properties.
2. Tobacco use is allowed providing users monitor their proximity to fuel sources and stay outside of the posted and recommended safe distances. Smoking will not be allowed in the bleacher sections of the event.
3. Absolutely no horseplay or exhibitions of speed (i.e; burnouts, drifting, etc.) will be tolerated during the event.
4. All posted speed limits will be strictly enforced. This includes the taxi way return for cars participating in the races.
5. Participants and Spectators will abide by all directions given to them by event staff.
6. No Spectator vehicles will be allowed past the designated event parking area. In the event that Spectators have handicap needs please contact the nearest event staff member and they will address individual and specific needs.
7. Please use proper receptacles for refuse disposal. The airport directors were very supportive of this event and we'd like to “leave it like we found it” for them.
8. All race participant vehicles will be subject to technical inspection to ensure their vehicle is safe to race.
9. Each driver will be issued a purple wrist band. The wrist band must be worn throughout the entire event and must be displayed EVERY time a driver enters the course.
10. All drivers will wear vehicle equipped seatbelts while racing.
11. All drivers will keep their vehicle equipped windows rolled up while racing.
12. Helmets are required for convertibles, motorcycles, or any other vehicle not having a solid roof.
13. Eye protection is required for any vehicle that does not have a windscreen attached to the vehicle.
14. Spectators will not be allowed to bring coolers, portable shades, chairs, or other “camping” type equipment to the bleacher area. Seat cushions are acceptable.
15. Spectators are not allowed beyond the safety wall. All racing will be suspended until all spectators are in a safe area.
16. In the event of an accident spectators are to stay clear of the affected area so emergency personnel can operate without interference.
